[Scripture Explanations 01.01] My dear children! With the following “memory supplements” I want to give you a very important and useful rule, without which you cannot hope to gain any use from reading spiritually good books. Even if you would read though the Holy Scriptures and then this New Word a thousand times, without this rule you will always be stuck on the same spot.

You have crammed your brains full by frequent reading, but ask your spirit what is the benefit and its blunt answer will be:

“I am chaotically besieged by all kinds of building material, and here the beams and stones are piled on top of each other. But from all this building material not even one miserable shack has been built in which I would be able to live independently. You continue to pile on the building material – many gems and the finest cedar wood lie in stumpy piles before me – and I am unable to organize it. Just when I start to manage some kind of order, you add a gigantic amount of new materials yet again, and thus I tire in my task. At the end, when looking at the size of materials to order I shiver and wistfully think about when all this material can finally be organized and made into a home.”

You see, the spirit has answered very thoroughly. This answer has to be sought by every person who has read any amount.

If somebody reads a few thousand books throughout the course of his life, in what a mess his thoughts are at the end! And if it goes well, after having read so widely he will produce just so much that he will only then realize that he knows nothing.

But what is this confession? It is nothing more than the very same wistful lamentation of the spirit, which is trying to say that it cannot possibly turn a run-down shack into a free home with such a huge amount of building material.

True, there are people who can recite by heart the passages of The Old and New Testaments. However if you ask them about the inner meaning of just a single verse, it becomes clear that they know about as much as someone who doesn't know a single verse by heart or even perhaps scarcely aware that a Holy Scripture even exists. Of what use then can such wonderful material be to such people?

The spirit can only be found in spiritual people. Should he not be able to build even a poor shack in the inner spirit of truth from this material, where then should he live, run his accounts and exactly where should he start to sort out the material?

Is it not thus better to own less material and to use it to build a small, respectable home for the spirit? It then has a fixed place from which it can make its next plans and use more newly arriving material?

What would a field look like if it were of the most fertile soil and thus thousands of seeds were sown simultaneously and without the slightest trace of any order? The seeds would

Chapter 9

THREE IMPORTANT QUESTIONS OF MUCIUS AND THE LORD ANSWERS HIS QUESTIONS

When the meal was finished, the innkeeper **Mucius** said to Me: "Lord and Master, I am really eager to ask a few questions now that are clearly on my heart because of our conversation of yesterday. There are no more Pharisees present who listen to us so that question and answer can unhindered be asked and given. So if You permit, O Lord, I would like to request from You to answer my questions."

Jesus to His disciples:

"But of course, if men go too much astray and become entangled in the enticements of the world, and if they do not discover the real sense of their lives there can be no

question of a real, higher revelation of God and His will of love. That can only take place when men begin to think due to all kinds of need and misery, at least up to the point that they will ask: 'Why actually did we have to come into this miserable world, and why must we actually let ourselves be tormented and tortured unto our certain death, which is the miserable ending of our despair?' ...

Then the moment has come on which God will again reveal Himself to men, first by the mouth of awakened men, and by other signs, but also by all sorts of judgment over those people who became rich and mighty, proud and loveless and very arrogant through all kinds of lies and deceptions and the suppression of the poor and the weak...

Once the measure among men on the world will be full, a great judgment will come, and together with that, also a great, direct revelation from God to men who in their heart will still believe in God and who have thus also kept the love for Him and their fellowman.

Then those who deny God and the proud deceivers and suppressors **will be wiped off the surface of the Earth**, and those who believe and the poor will be raised up and be enlightened from the Heavens, as this is the case now, and as it will be the case again later **in almost 2.000 years**. The time, in which this can, and also certainly will take place, is as easy to recognize as can be seen in the late winter when spring draws near and you look at the trees and see how their buds are swelling more and more and become more juicy and how the juice, just like the tears of men, will drop down from their branches and twigs on the soil, and in a certain way are begging for deliverance from the need of the winter in which so many trees were pining away."
